Reports:

GVFC-Chief Saul Schmolitz-provided written report to Supervisors. Chief Schmolitz expressed appreciation for the fire company crew members for taking courses and training offered to them. Five members took the National Firefighter 1 exam and 10 different members went to York County for 7.5 hours of fire training. Chairman Rish appreciated all their efforts and felt it was impressive that even with changes one week prior to the exam that all passed. Mr. Brown thanked fire department for their efforts in the Friday windstorm which caused wires down and fallen trees. Mr. Leese asked for clarification on the vehicles used in a brush fire situation. Presently, the Attack Truck used for brush and land fires. The 5-ton vehicle is also used for brush fires. Wayne Isett is proud of the 5 graduates (3 male/2 female).

<u>Fort Indiantown Gap-David Weisnicht</u>-Shared there will be a lot of high noise training that will be noticed by public. Demolition training on May 10 & 14 8am-5pm and Mortar live-fire training May 21 & 22 8am-9pm. There was a pre bid conference for the construction of 2 access control points and looking toward breaking ground but it will probably several years to completion. More information to come on the Annual Butterfly Walk that will be held virtually in the early part of July.

Unfinished Business:

Consideration of CFA Grants relative to MS4

Aaron Moyer explained the CFA GTRP grant application submission due 5/31/2021 would provide financial assistance to build out the improvements identified in the master plan for EHT Community Park. There are requirements to do work under MS4 Program whether the Township obtains grant funding. Mr. Smith made a motion to authorize HRG to apply for CFA Greenways, Trails and Recreation Grant not to exceed \$13,245 and charged to the engineering expense budget for the grant application and administrative fees. Mr. Brown seconded. Roll Call Vote: Mr. Brown-yes; Mr. Smith-yes; Mr. Leese-yes; Chairman Rish-yes. Motion carried 4-0.

Consideration of Fire Reimbursement Ordinance-

Mr. Smith made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2021-2 pertaining to the reimbursement of certain costs incurred by the Grantville Volunteer Fire Company. Mr. Brown seconded. Roll Call Vote: Mr. Brown-yes; Mr. Smith-yes; Mr. Leese-yes; Chairman Rish-yes. Motion carried 4-0.

New Business:

Request to extend Audit for one year with Boyer and Ritter LLC

Mr. Smith made a motion to extend Audit engagement for a one more year with Boyer and Ritter LLC in **2022 at a cost of \$12,000**. (Audit period FY 2021). Mr. Leese seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Accept resignation of P&R Director Jhane Kunkel

Mr. Cornell shared that Jhane Kunkel has given Township a letter of resignation. She and her family have an opportunity to move to another location. Jhane stated she is willing to continue part-time until her replacement is found. **Board consensus to table until next meeting to discuss at an Executive Session**.

Hanover Logistics-Acceptance of Time Extension for Review

The planning commission has recommended acceptance of time extension at their April 27, 2021 meeting for Grantville Hanover Logistic 1 & 2 Land Development Plan. Mr. Leese made a **motion to accept the time extension until July 20, 2021.** Mr. Smith seconded. **Motion carried 4-0**.

Dairy Lane Subdivision-Request for Extension of Conditional Approval

Consideration of time extension requested by the developer of the 392 & 410 Dairy Lane Subdivision Plan to meet conditions of plan approval. Mr. Leese made a motion to grant an additional 90-day extension to meet conditions of the plan approval until August 16, 2021. Mr. Brown seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Mr. Brown asked for an update on Township Building due to last week's the fire call incident. Bryan Ziegler stated that the HVAC company finished cleaning ducts. Air purification units to be picked up tomorrow morning.
