MEETING MINUTES - December 3, 2020

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM

- 1. Motion made by Laurie Reichert to approve minutes from November, 2020 board meeting. 2nd by Dave Hamaty. Approved by all present: 5-0.
- 2. Review detailed Receipts and Expenditures Report thru November, 2020.

Guest: Bryan Ziegler: Updated the Board on the following items:

- 1. Well near small soccer field (Athletic Fields). Access to water.
- 2. New Parking lot next the small soccer field.
- 3. Railroad ties could be used on a bed of stone at soccer field.
- 4. Met Ed providing free telephone poles. Use phone poles with cable and install post and cable along the road connecting ball fields. Height: 18"? 30"?
- 5. Purchase and install a pavilion on cement slab in an area: 60' X 90'. Estimated pavilion size: 28' X 48". Electricity and well on the premises.
- 6. Baseball shed (block building): seal the outside (leakage). Paint the sides tan and the roof blue. Remove vinyl siding. Replace with T111. Review grading.
- 7. P & R Annex: ADA ramp is completed. Walkway is done. Handicap sign installed.
- 8. VFW Nature Trail Large loop hopefully done this month.
- 9. Swing set to be completed this year.

P/R Directors Report – Jhane's Park Project Report (attached):

- 1. **VFW Property Nature Trails:** Mapped out by Jhane, Bryan, Karen, Laurie.
- 2. **Soccer parking lot:** Almost done. Soccer benches layout evaluated with Neil Cooper. Better placement.
- 3. Nature Trail: Jhane has not heard back from the Scout.
- 4. Rotted steps on Nature Trail: Public Works to replace them.
- 5. **Stone Trail Additions:** rerouted trails. Working on securing permit for additional expansion.
- 6. **Nature Park proposal (VFW grounds):** Approved by BOS for 2021 Budget to include: sign, portable toilet, bathroom possibilities to be researched.

- 7. Parking Lot painting: will be done in-house 2021.
- 8. Reevaluate current tournament contract with EH Baseball & Softball Assoc.
- 9. **Additional Swing set located**: installation to be between soccer field and NEW parking lot at Youth Sports Complex.
- 10. Running Water from well (Youth Sports Complex) to Storage Shed at ball field.
- 11. Short-term Lease Contract needed for athletic fields: Jhane reached out to Lee, the solicitor. Need time to work on it. Nothing more on it at this time.
- 12. **Digital Newsletter:** Quote from Graphtech. For now, designing a postcard to be mailed to residents to register for digital communications with the Township for P & R events.
- 13. **2021 Pavilion Replacement:** declined during budget hearing. Bryan suggested building a NEW pavilion at the Youth Sports Complex. Bare bones pavilion on a cement slab as described above by Bryan during our meeting. Estimated materials purchase: \$15,000. Researching additional estimates.
- 14. ADA Ramp for Park & Rec Annex: Being completed by Public Works.
- 15. **Website:** BOS approved Jhane & Paul to move forward with redesign and hosting of NEW site. Vendor selected.
- 16. Free Telephone Poles/posts: MetEd offered them. Bryan and Jhane investigated other parks' usage as barrier. Post & cable. Use at the Youth Sports Complex along access road.
- 17. **Tennis Courts**: Approved by BOS. Jhane has a quote and work could begin spring, 2021.

Events:

- Christmas Wonderland Event (12/5) 2-4P (Rain date 12/6):
 - i. Registration Table Check in. Arrive by 12:30-1P.
 - ii. Carriage ride reservations 35. 4 people/ride. 5 minutes.
 - iii. Pony Rides 26 divided amongst 3 ponies.
 - iv. Gazebo decorated for photo ops.
 - v. Beverages & refreshments to tables.
 - vi. Volunteers at Registration Table, Snacks Table, help vendors if necessary.

2021 Goals with tentative completion dates:

- Open some VFW grounds nature trails by 6-1-21. Complete by 9-30-21.
 - Starting Wednesday (12/9/20)
- Install a Park Sign at VFW entrance that matches the Main Park sign. Use blue metal roof for both entrance signs, including existing sign at Main Park by 6-1-21.
- Finish trail extension in the Main Park by 6-1-21.
 - Improve trails (Main Park) in some spots they don't wash out or redesign in

those problem areas by 6-1-21.

- b. Resolving this year
- Repair/renovate pavilion at VFW grounds so rentals are a possibility by 6-1-21.
 - Potentially late spring
- Build new pavilion at the Main Park near ball fields if approved 2020 for purchase.

2022 Goals:

- Connect northern and southern sides of park with a bridge.
- Replace small stage at Main Park. (most likely grant depend.)
- Replace playground equipment. (most likely grant depend.)

3-5 Year Goals:

- Master Plan developed for VFW property
- Dog Park.
- Connect the Main Park with the VFW Grounds (Nature Park) in a safe manner. Painting crosswalk on Old Jonestown Rd., etc. (needs twp. ordinance for crosswalk starts with lee, requires traffic study in house)

Additional Notes on In-Person Meeting with Public Works Friday, Dec. 4th 7:30am:

Work on the Youth Sports Complex (North side of the Community Park):

- Parking lot on the other side of the soccer fields.
 - o Projected to be done in 2021
 - Needs permit to finish
- Swing Set build
 - Agreed on location
 - Will be complete by April 2021
 - No permit needed
- Water line to the baseball shed

PW found conduits already existing to the electric panel of the storage

- Just needs installation
- Needs a few fittings and wire
- Updating the baseball shed
 - Sealing from water
 - Removing the siding and replacing with T1-11 where people have been throwing balls against the building, breaking the vinyl siding
 - Potential blue roof
- Potential pavilion build (in stages) near the new parking lot
 - Discovered in master site plan to build on this side
 - Trying to purchase before year's end to store
- Fencing with post and cable for around soccer fields
- Med Ed is giving us used telephone posts to cut into fence posts
- Wire comes from guide rail replacements from PW
- Will be completed when Bryan feels like it, jk, by Memorial Day weekend
