- Resurfacing the courts: Done.

- Existing Front Bridge Repainted. Done.
- Soccer nets: Done.
- **Soccer parking lot:** Receiving free stone from another project. Acquired 300 free telephone poles to create a barrier around the soccer fields.
- **Nature Trail:** Awaiting Eagle Scout project approval: add signage, mile markers, and plant ID markers.

- **Stone Trail Additions:** Adjusting permit to accommodate change in trail. Fall project.

- Drive in Movie: September 11th: Create slideshow before movie. .
- Additional Swing set located: To be placed at Youth Sports Complex.
- Short-term Lease Contract needed for athletic fields: Jhane to work with Lee on this.
- **Digital Newsletter:** Jhane working on revitalizing the newsletter. Principal at Sand Beach Elementary referred her to Jim Hazen, Lower Dauphin Director of

Communications, to get approval for Jhane to send to parents of students. Waiting for him to return her call.

Old Business:

- National Night Out: TBD.
- **Peach Fest**: Drive thru distribution at the fire house went well. 30+ cars. Had help from New Cumberland Federal Credit Union. They want to help again.

New Business:

- Fall Festival (10/24): Turn it into a daytime event with activities outside.
 - Pumpkin carving out side on tarps, blankets, in parking lot.
 - Hayride (limited number of riders).
 - Take reservations and assign families a work area that includes carving tools, drinks, snacks, etc.
- Holiday Craft Project: Replace wreath making. Schedule for November. Fall wreath. Stumps to decorate.
- Halloween Parade (10/15): Reverse drive thru at the fire station. Hand out goodie bags. Still have competition. Decorate cars, costumes, etc.
- **Tree Lighting (12/5):** Turn it into a daytime event like a "walk in the Park." Have activities and photography stations. Discuss at next month's meeting.
- Relay for Life Presentation (9/12). Rain date 10/19.
- Volunteer Day: Help with clean up at the Park. Extensive list of chores for both main park and VFW grounds. Perhaps plant more trees.

- Finish trail extension in the Main Park.
- Connect north and south portions of the Park. Bridge to cross the creek.

- Improve trails (Main Park) in some spots they don't wash out or redesign in those problem areas.
- Establish nature trails at VFW picnic grounds. Develop Nature Park.
- Repair/renovate pavilion at VFW grounds so rentals are a possibility.
- Replace the small pavilion at main park that was removed.
