RESOLUTION 2024- 7

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST HANOVER,
DAUPHIN COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA,
SETTING THE TOWNSHIP FEE SCHEDULE FOR 2024**

BE IT RESOLVED that the fees are set as follows for 2024:

Subdivision plans & residential land development plans: \$100 base fee plus \$50 per lot or unit

- In addition to the Township fee, an application fee will be charged by the Dauphin County Planning Commission per its fee schedule and will be paid by the applicant
- All Township Engineer review and inspection fees will be reimbursed by the applicant
- All Township Solicitor review fees will be reimbursed by the applicant
- All recording fees will be paid by the applicant
- Applicant will be required to establish and maintain a \$3,000 escrow account per Resolution No. 2024-6
- Recreation fee-in-lieu of dedicated park and recreation land for new dwelling units and/or lots to be used for residential purposes: \$2,000 per new unit or lot

Non-residential land development plans: \$500 for the first acre or fraction of acre plus \$10 for each additional acre or fraction of acre

- In addition to the Township fee, an application fee will be charged by the Dauphin County Planning Commission per its fee schedule and will be paid by the applicant
- All Township Engineer review and inspection fees will be reimbursed by the applicant
- All Township Solicitor review fees will be reimbursed by the applicant
- All recording fees will be paid by the applicant
- Applicant will be required to establish and maintain a \$3,000 escrow account per Resolution No. 2024-6

Major/minor stormwater management permit application fee: \$100

- All Township Engineer review and inspection fees will be reimbursed by the applicant
- All Township Solicitor review fees will be reimbursed by the applicant
- All recording fees will be paid by the applicant
- Applicant will be required to establish and maintain a \$2,000 escrow account per Resolution No. 2024-6
- Major stormwater permits require financial security in an amount to be determined by the Township Engineer

Driveway permit: \$50

- Refer to PennDOT fee schedule and application process for driveway permits along state roads

Street cut permit: \$100

- Escrow may be required based on the nature and extent of the work being performed

Annual licenses:

- Annual mobile home park license: \$100 plus \$2 per unit
- Annual septic hauler/pumper license: \$20
- Annual junk yard license: \$100

Review fees by Township Engineer or Township Solicitor: As per Resolution No. 2024-5

UCC plan review and inspection fees: As per Resolution No. 2024-5

Sewage Enforcement Officer fees: As per Resolution No. 2024-5

Zoning-related fees:

- Zoning permit application: \$100
- Zoning verification letter: \$50
- Special exception application: \$500
- Conditional use application: \$500
- Zoning variance application/appeal: \$500
- Zoning change: \$500
- Curative amendment: \$2,500
- Text amendment: \$500

Small wireless facilities fees:

- Application for up to five (5) collocated small wireless facilities: \$500 plus \$100 for each collocated small wireless facility beyond five (5)
- Application for small wireless facility requiring the installation of a new or replacement utility pole: \$1,000
- Annual fee for use and occupancy of Township right-of-way by a small wireless facility: \$270 per small wireless facility or new utility pole with a small wireless facility

Fees for paper documents, copies, etc.:

- Zoning ordinance with map: \$35
- Zoning map: \$3
- Subdivision and land development ordinance: \$25
- Stormwater management ordinance: \$15
- Recreation plan: \$15
- Comprehensive plan: \$35
- Copies: \$0.25 per side for letter size or smaller, \$0.50 per side for larger than letter size
- Faxes: \$0.50 per side
- CDs: \$2
- Flash drive: \$5
- Mailed copies/items: Per the above plus postage
